

The Veterans of Safety Safety, Health and Environmental Scholarship Guidelines

Beginning in 2000, the Veterans of Safety Scholarship recipient is to be named annually. The award will be derived from the earned interest of the contributions made to the Safety Scholarship Fund. The number and amount of the award will be determined by the Selection Committee. The recipient of this award must be enrolled as a full-time student for two consecutive enrollment periods and continue as a student in good standing. The Selection Committee has the right to name more than one recipient. The guidelines for determining the recipient are as follows:

- I. Criteria for Eligibility
 - A. Applicant must have a grade point average overall of 2.5 and 3.0 in their major.
 - B. Applicant must have been admitted to a safety-related program.
 - C. If applicant has begun graduate study prior to April 15, the student must have a minimum of 15 semester hours of graduate credit remaining on the graduate program and must have a cumulative minimum grade point average of 3.5 on all study completed.

- II. Criteria for Selection of Recipient
 - A. A record of high scholastic achievement while an undergraduate student.
 - B. Demonstrated outstanding leadership abilities.
 - C. Applicant must possess high standards of character as evidenced by the statements of applicant's peers, employers, and instructors.

- III. Procedures for Applying for the Award
 - A. Student must apply for the scholarship on the attached form.
 - B. Student must submit an application to the Scholarship Committee Office, Humphreys 201, CMSU, Warrensburg, Missouri, 64093.
 - C. Student must request letters from a minimum of four references including a letter from a student, a faculty or staff member, and a person not directly associated with the institution being attended. Letters are to be mailed to the Scholarship Committee Office.
 - D. Student must request that an official transcript of the student's academic record be forwarded by the University's Registrar, to the Scholarship Committee Office. The student should also request the Registrar to forward to the Scholarships Committee Office, a statement indicating that the student has applied for an undergraduate degree and upon satisfactory completion of all work, will receive a degree in Safety or a related field.

- IV. Selection and Announcement of Recipient
 - A. The selection of the recipient will be made by a committee comprised of representatives of the Veterans of Safety.
 - B. The award and announcement of the recipient will be made during the annual Veterans of Safety President's Reception.
